

Prom Early Dismissal Policy

Parents/Guardians and Students:

Please read the list of rules given below and sign the appropriate spaces. The lower half should be turned in to the class advisor. Keep the upper portion for future reference. Students who do not turn in a signed slip will not be dismissed early the day of prom.

1. Juniors and seniors attending prom are permitted to leave after 4th period on the day of prom, provided they bring in a note from their parent/guardian. **(The note is the bottom portion of this sheet).**
2. The notes are due by the specified date given by the class advisor – April 1st. **Regardless of age of the student, a parent or guardian must sign the note.** Career Center Students are also required to bring in a note.
3. **No 9th or 10th grade student** is permitted to leave school early for prom preparations. It will be considered an illegal absence and treated accordingly.
4. No students will be given a legal excuse to miss school at any other time for prom preparations. While prom is a special event, remember that education comes first.
