The Greenville Symphony Orchestra, founded in 1929, aims to bring culture and quality classical music to the Greenville community and the surrounding area. In order to promote interest, growth, and appreciation of fine classical music, the orchestra is once again recognizing a gifted and qualified high school Senior through an annual scholarship award. The Scholarship award for this year is in the amount of \$1000.00, and the winner will be presented at GSO Spring Concert on Saturday, April 15, 2023 at 7:30 PM; the 2023 GSO Scholarship Award winner will be required to attend the 2023 GSO Spring Concert in order to receive this award

Seniors from area high schools presently participating in music activities, and <u>seeking to</u> <u>continue their studies and education in the field of music</u> are encouraged to apply for this

ELIGIBILITY and APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:

The successful scholarship candidate will submit an application <u>including</u> the following information and documentation:

- Candidate presently a member of the Senior Class of 2023 and in good academic standing at their high school, verified by completion of Guidance Counselor Endorsement on application form.
- Candidate presently involved in some area of music (vocally or instrumentally), i.e. a member of the Band, Orchestra, Choir, Church Choir, Musical Theatre, etc., verified by a <u>complete</u> chronological listing of the candidate's past and present musical activities, included details of special accomplishments and awards.
- Minimum of <u>three-(3)</u> Letters of Reference from any/all Musical Directors of music activities, (i.e. Orchestra Director, Band Director, Choral Director, Instrumental Music Teacher, Vocal Coach, Church Choir Director, Musical Theatre Director, etc.) with first-hand knowledge of candidate's involvement in music activities.
- A personal essay (typed; minimum of 500 words) reflecting the candidate's potential, personality, and character; detailing past and current musical activities, special abilities, and talents, as well as <u>future musical goals</u>, <u>aspirations</u>, and <u>educational plans</u>; and including a statement of how this scholarship award will benefit the candidate's future musical education.
- ❖ It is required that the winning candidate be in attendance at the GSO Spring Concert to be held on Saturday, April 15th, 2023, 7:30 PM, in the William A Passavant Center on the campus of Thiel College, Greenville, PA. to receive this award.
