Families are responsible for transportation to and from the program and pocket money. Students must remain in residence for the full two-week program, including weekends. Scholars must attend all classes, labs, and activities. PSEAS cannot provide special facilities or alter schedules for formal athletic training, intensive music study, or other commitments unrelated to the program.
